

# CCNx Contributor Agreement v1.0

March 11, 2010

In order to become a Contributor – that is to have the ability to post or submit materials of any kind (“Contribution”) that become part of a CCNx release or source code or data repository – you (“You”) must indicate your agreement to the terms below by completing and signing this agreement and returning it to the Palo Alto Research Center, Inc. (“PARC”) as specified at <http://www.ccnx.org/notification>.

## 2. Treatment of Personal Information

You agree that Your name and email address, or a derivative of it, as well as Contributions You submit will be maintained indefinitely and may be visible worldwide via the Internet and redistributed at PARC's discretion.

## 3. Treatment of Accounts

You may at some point receive one or more sets of CCNx project access credentials. You will not allow anyone else to use such credentials to access any CCNx project system or repository. Should You become aware of any such use, You will immediately notify PARC as specified at <http://www.ccnx.org/notification>; until such notice is received You will be presumed to have taken all actions made using Your credentials. PARC and its designates will have complete control and discretion over capabilities associated with Your credentials and may change them for any reason at any time.

## 4. License Terms

Contributions to the CCNx project must be governed by an appropriate license: the GNU General Public License version 2 (“GPL”) for programs, the GNU Lesser General Public License version 2.1 (“LGPL”) for libraries, the Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 3.0 license for non-code, or another license declared to be acceptable to the project for the Contribution in question as published in writing at <http://www.ccnx.org/license>. PARC will have discretion to determine which license is appropriate for any particular Contribution. You will verify that code Contributions contain appropriate boilerplate licensing text.

## 5. Contributing the Work of Others

You may submit a Contribution that was not written by You, provided that:

- a) The accompanying message or checkin comment contains information (or references to information) sufficient to identify the author of the Contribution, including at minimum an email address; and
- b) You make all reasonable and appropriate efforts to ensure that such Contribution conforms to the terms of this agreement.

## 6. Cryptography

You understand that cryptographic code may be subject to government regulations with which PARC and/or entities using such code must comply. Any Contribution which contains any of the items listed below will be treated as cryptographic code:

- a) Cryptographic capabilities or features; or
- b) Calls to cryptographic features; or
- c) User interface elements which provide context relating to cryptography; or
- d) Code which may, under casual inspection, appear to be cryptographic.

Cryptographic code can be contributed to any CCNx software product explicitly identified as using cryptography. Cryptography is used extensively in CCNx software, so most or all CCNx products have already been so identified. The current list of explicitly

identified cryptography products may be found at <http://www.ccnx.org/crypto>. If You wish to contribute cryptographic code to a product that is not already explicitly identified as containing cryptography, such as a new product, You must first notify PARC and obtain written approval. For cryptographic Contributions, You will follow any guidelines that may be published at <http://www.ccnx.org/crypto> or communicated to You directly, to help the project organize and track cryptographic code for the widest possible distribution and use consistent with regulations.

## **7. Support**

You are not expected to provide support of any kind for Your Contributions. You may provide support for free, for a fee, or not at all at Your option. Unless required by law or separately agreed to in writing, You provide your Contributions on an 'AS IS' BASIS, WITHOUT WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF ANY KIND, either express or implicit, including, without limitation, any warranties or conditions of TITLE, NON-INFRINGEMENT, MERCHANTABILITY, or FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

## **8. Notices and Knowledge**

By submitting a Contribution, You confirm that, to the best of Your knowledge:

- a) License notices have been appropriately placed; and
- b) The Contribution does not violate the rights of any person or entity.

If you submit a Contribution on behalf of Your employer, or created through work for Your employer, then You must assure that an appropriate representative of that employer has authorized the Contribution under the terms of this agreement.

## **9. Governing Law**

These terms will be governed by the laws of the State of California and applicable U.S. Federal law. Any choice of law rules will not apply.
